Training can be a vital tool in introducing the concepts of management systems, helping organisations successfully implement systems and assisting in the improved performance of the business through the monitoring and auditing of compliance to standards.

TPECS is a RABQSA competency-based training certification that is designed to give individuals the necessary skills to get the best out of their management systems, and also offers globally recognised levels of attainment so that delegates can prove their competence of relevant standards

BSI Group Australia & New Zealand offers RABQSA TPECS courses in Quality Management Systems, Environmental Management Systems and OH&S Management Systems.

How does the flexible course structure work?

Due to the flexible delivery of the courses, delegates can choose to gain an overview and level of attainment in each of the different standards and also gain competency in auditing and leading an audit team. There are 5 different competency units whose outcomes are certified by RABQSA:

- ✓ **QM** – Quality Management Systems
- ✓ **EM** – Environmental Management Systems
- ✓ **OH** – OH&S Management Systems
- ✓ **AU** – Management Systems Auditing
- ✓ **TL** – Leading Management Systems Audit Teams

Delegates attend a 2 day 'Requirements' course to gain competency units in a particular standard (**QM**, **EM** or **OH**) and then add competency units in Management Systems Auditing (**AU**) and Leading Management Systems Audit Teams (**TL**) by 'topping-up' with an extra 2 days of training either immediately or at a later date.

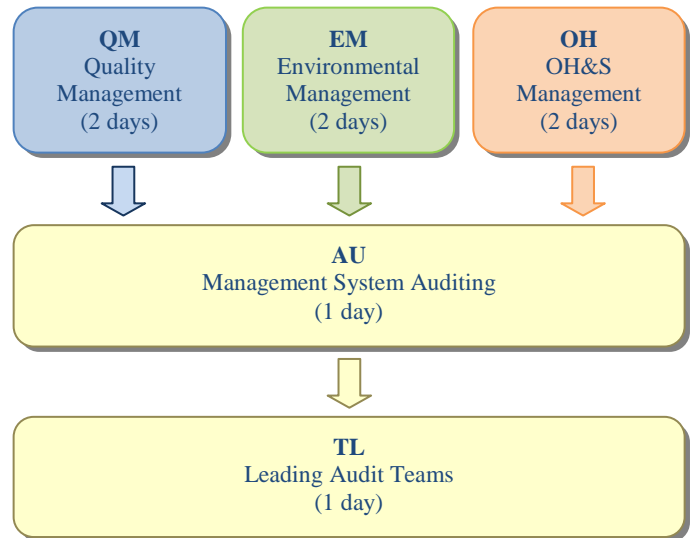
The 'Management Systems Auditing' and 'Leading Management Systems Audit Teams' competency units are not specific to an individual management system, so once Lead Auditor competence has been attained in one standard it is only necessary to attend 2 more days of training to gain Lead Auditor Certification in another Management System.

Attain Lead Auditor qualifications in just 4 days

Delegates who want to become a Lead Auditor in a particular standard can achieve this in just 4 days, quicker than previously possible, and with no loss of content or valuable skills building. This reduces the time out of the workplace, giving more opportunity to implement learning in the working environment. Delegates can become a Lead Auditor at their own pace, accomplishing their learning outcomes in either 2 separate 2 day courses or as 1 consecutive 4 day course.

Delegates can be RABQSA certified as a Lead Auditor in Quality, Environmental and OH&S Management Systems with a total of just 8 days training, meaning less time away from the working environment and better value for money for organisations.

Competency exams are retaken electronically so there is no need to return to the course venue once the course has been completed, unless of course you are choosing to attend another course and add extra competency units.



In House Delivery Options

All RABQSA TPECS courses can also be delivered on an in-house basis. Trainers can deliver courses on your premises minimising disruption to your business. In-house training is suitable for larger groups and is a cost effective training option.

OHSAS 18001 & AS/NZS 4801 – OH&S Management Systems

- ✓ OHSAS 18001:2007 Requirements – 2 days
- ✓ ISO 14001:2004 Lead Auditor – 4 days (or 2 day 'top-up'. From either the ISO 9001 or ISO 14001 Lead auditor course).
